**XIth School, State and National Level Painting Competition on Energy Conservation –
2015 for Category ‘A’ and ‘B’**

The Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Govt. of India, Ministry of Power is organizing XIth School, State and National Level Painting Competition on Energy Conservation – 2015 for Category ‘A’ (4th, 5th and 6th standard students) and Category ‘B’ (7th, 8th and 9th standard students). Cash award for XIth School, State and National Level Painting Competition will be given as per list attached. National Institute of Open Schooling would take this opportunity to extend the programme for its Accredited Agencies under Open Basic Education Programme.

Category of the Competition

The Painting Competition will be held for Category ‘A’ and Category ‘B’. Category ‘A’ will be applicable for **Level ‘B’** of OBE (equivalent to standard V of the formal school system) and Category ‘B’ for **Level ‘C’** of OBE (equivalent to standard VIII of the formal school system).

Criteria for Selection of AA

The Painting Competition will be held at Accredited Agency (AA). Presently approx. 928 AA are accredited with OBE Programme of NIOS. For this competition only 127 have been considered as their admission and result data for previous session i.e. 2014-15 has been updated. Keeping in view that this is the first time such an opportunity is being provided to AAs it is proposed that out of these 127 AA maximum 04 AA will be randomly shortlisted from each state to participate in this event.

Procedure for entry in Competition

A. School Level Completion

- i. A two hour painting competition will be organized by Accredited Agency at their school premise. Drawing material will be provided by AA. The painting should be on following theme Topics:

Category ‘A’	Category ‘B’
Save Energy, Save Environment	Save Electricity to light more homes
Leaks make your future bleak	Don’t be cruel, Conserve your fuel
कुकड़ूक् सूरज निकला, लाइट जलाएं क्यूँ (With sun light, why not switch off light)	एलईडी (LED) बल्ब एक सही सोच (LED Bulb, an apt thought)

- ii. Two best paintings along with the information on the total no. of participants and percentage participation of students in both categories will be sent to the address of nodal

officer of your area (list may be downloaded from http://www.beeindia.in/NECA-2015/Nodal_Official_2015.pdf) A copy of the letter along with a copy of the entries may also be forwarded to NIOS HQ as well as the respective Regional Centre.

iii. Kindly mention following information at the back of painting:

- iv. All participating students will get a 'Certificate of Participation' and 1st and 2nd selected will get 'Certificate of Merit'.
- v. The name of AA/School with 100% participation for both categories at school level competition will be included in the painting competition booklet.

B. School Level Competition

- i. The entries at office of the Nodal Officers will be scrutinized and top 50 selected students from each category will be eligible for participation in state level competition. The List of these 50 students will be uploaded on www.beeindia.in. The same will be communicated to the respective AA/school by concerned Nodal Officer by 1st November, 2015 to participate in State Level Competition on 6th November, 2015 at selected venue.
- ii. The selected candidates need to be carried following material:
- Letter from school or ID Card
 - 2 latest passport size photograph
 - Painting material
- iii. The students participating in the state level event will be paid Rs. 1000/- cash. The conveyance charges for student and his/her 02 guardians will also be paid for shortest route for sleeper AC Chair Car/3rd AC rail fair/ State roadways bus.
- iv. Competition for Category 'B' will be terminated at Sate/UT level and first three selected entries will be sent for evaluation for National Level competition.

C. National Level Painting Competition

- i. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize winners of State/UT level competition for Category 'A' will be invited for National Level Competition on 12th December, 2015 along with 02 guardians.
- ii. The boarding and lodging for student and his/her 02 guardians will also be paid for shortest route for sleeper AC Chair Car/3rd AC rail fair/ State roadways bus.
- iii. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize winners of each State/UT level competition for Category 'B' will be evaluated for National level competition. The boarding and lodging for winner and his/her 02 guardians will also be paid for shortest route for sleeper AC Chair Car/3rd

AC rail fair/ State roadways bus. The winner of the National level event will be paid Rs. 1000/- cash for participation in the programme at Delhi.

Note:

1. The AA should send the details of event at school level competition along with photograph, so that it can be included in News Bulletin of NIOS.
2. After the final result of State and National Level Competition, the AA would be required to inform about winner/s to the concerned Regional Centre and NIOS HQ so that it can be included in NIOS News Bulletin and NIOS website.
