**Clarification regarding the course on "Diploma in Dress Designing"
code 461,462,463,494.**

This is regarding the course on "Diploma in Dress Designing" which was launched from the session starting July 2014.

As clarifications were sought by the Regional Centers and Study centers hence, following is clarified based on the approved scheme. This course is having following four modules:

Sr.	Module Name	Code	Duration	Entry Level	Fees (AVI+NIOS)
1.	Basic Stitching Skills	461	6 months	8 th Pass	2000(1700+300)
2.	Children's Wear	462	6 months	8 th Pass	2000(1700+300)
3.	Ladies' Wear	463	6 months	8 th Pass	2000(1700+300)
4.	Men's Wear	494	6 months	8 th Pass	2000(1700+300)

This course will be offered as two year Diploma course having four modules as well as one year Certificate courses with multi entry and multi exit option.

Basic Stitching Skills (461) + Children's Wear (462)	Certificate in Children's Wear	1 year
Basic Stitching Skills(461) + Ladies' Wear (463)	Certificate in Ladies' Wear	1 year
Basic Stitching Skills(461) + Men's Wear(494)	Certificate in Men's Wear	1 year
Basic Stitching Skills(461) + Children's Wear(462) + Ladies' Wear (463)+ Men's Wear(494)	Diploma in Dress Designing	2 years

After getting certificate of 1 year, the learner will have the option to pursue another optional module for securing another certificate in six months. For example, if a learner does one year course on "Certificate in Children's Wear" and then wants to take "Certificate in Ladies Wear" he/she has to do only six months module on "Ladies Wear" and credits of the compulsory Module "Basic Stitching Skills" will be automatically transferred. After completion of 1 year certificate course, for taking additional modules the learner will have to fill the admission form again and has to fill his/her previous enrolment number. Only the module on basic stitching (461) is compulsory . The fees will be charged based on the module /modules selected.

The codes of the modules will be the same for "Diploma" as well as "Certificate" course.

Accordingly the Regional Directors may collect the fees and give admission to the desirous candidates.
