

Meaning

Mughal painting is a style of South Asian painting restricted to miniature art. It originated from a Persian miniature painting, and established largely in the court of the Mughal Empire of the 16th to 18th centuries. Miniature paintings are very small pattern designs were usually executed with minute details. The first Mughal emperor Babur, who was a man of aesthetic sensibilities, writing memoirs provided some decorated texts. His son patronized the art of Mughal miniature painting and bought few Parisian artists in India. The Persian tradition elaborately decorated borders framing the central image with a modified form of prominent perspective.


