

## Meaning

Jatiswara musical form has got the sections like Pallavi, Anupallavi and Charana. Several swarajatis are composed with multiple charanas in which the sahitya will be followed by its swaras. While the swarajatis in Bilahari and Khamas give an idea of the raga to a beginner, the swarajatis of Syamasastri in Bhairavi, Yadukula kamboji and Todi are the epitome of those ragas. Jatiswara is a musical form which belongs to abhyasa ganam. This is taught after geetas.
