- Q4.** All children are naturally motivated to learn and are capable of learning. Enlist the opportunities where children learn naturally. Explain any one opportunity which you think is most appropriate for learning and justify it with suitable examples.
- Q5.** Keeping in view the objectives of ECCE and developmental characteristics of pre-school children, the MWCD, in its Curriculum Framework (2013) has talked about Principles of Program Planning. Discuss those Principles of Program Planning of ECCE.
- Q6.** Planning is essential for every aspect of human activities. Discuss various types of program planning of ECCE based on different time scales with examples.
- Q7.** Define Theme Based Planning. Explain various steps in Theme Based Planning with suitable examples.
- Q8.** Continue to question 7, enlist some themes which you want to incorporate in ECCE program. Select any one and prepare a web plan on this theme.
- Q9.** Select any one theme of your choice and design a weekly plan on this theme for children of six years age group.
- Q10.** Enlist various parameters for inclusiveness which you think are essential for inclusion. Visit a preschool in your neighbourhood and study the inclusiveness of this school on various parameters enlisted by you.
