- Q4.** Observe your interaction with your elder and younger generations in different situations. Is it same for all? If not, discuss how you learned to behave differently with different people. Also comment on the factors responsible for the same.
- Q5.** Socio-emotional development is an important domain under domains of development. Observe and write report on the socio-emotional development of infant (0-1yr) and child (3-6 yr) with parent's consent.
- Q6.** Critically analyze the stages of moral development as proposed by psychologists Jean Piaget and Lawrence Kohlberg with the help of suitable examples from day to day life.
- Q7.** Cognitive development proceeds with child's maturity. Explain how cognitive development takes place from birth to maturation of the child.
- Q8. Continue to Q7.** There are cognitive limitations that characterize children's cognition at The Pre-Operational Stage (2-7 years).
